BGSU Education Abroad Travel Grants

For strongest consideration, applicants should apply prior to the deadlines.

Applicants are required to submit a brief essay. Students participating in trips shorter than the previously required minimum of 3 weeks and students who have previously received Travel Grants may apply, although preference will be shown as listed below.

Applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- U.S. citizen or U.S. Alien
- Must be a BGSU degree-seeking student
- Must have a free application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file in the student Financial Aid Office

Applications will be evaluated based upon the following:

- Academic standing
- Application essay
- Financial need
- Preference will be given to students that have been accepted to a study abroad program lasting at least 3 weeks.
- Preference will be given to students who have not previously received the International Travel Grant.

Students are encouraged to submit their applications prior to the dates below for strongest consideration. Travel grants will be awarded based on availability of funds.

Spring Semester Abroad – November 1, 2012 Summer Term Abroad – March 1, 2013 Fall/Academic Year Abroad – May 1, 2013

Students who receive a travel grant will be required to volunteer eight (8) hours for Education Abroad the semester they return to BGSU. Students graduating immediately following their time abroad must fulfill the

requirement prior to their study abroad experience, or while abroad.
