

## Hansen Fellowship Nomination Form

### Nomination Process

Students considered for the Hansen Fellowship must be nominated by an applied faculty member hearing the BGSU audition. To nominate a student for the fellowship, faculty members must submit a written recommendation, detailing reasons why the student merits receiving a Hansen Fellowship. Please only submit nominations for students that you feel are truly exceptional and that you feel will be competitive for this special recognition.

### Student Eligibility and Criteria

Students must satisfy the following criteria in order to be considered for the Hansen Fellowship.

- Demonstration of exceptional musical performance through BGSU audition and related performance activity
- Acceptance to BGSU and the College of Musical Arts as a music major
- Minimum TOEFL score of 71 (for International Students)
- Nomination by BGSU applied faculty member

### Completing the Application

Once a student is nominated for the fellowship, they will be contacted by the Hansen Fellowship Committee (HFC) to complete their application. Students nominated will be required to submit a video audition recording with the same repertoire performed for their BGSU audition, a letter of recommendation, and complete an interview with members of the HFC. Interviews will be conducted either in person or online.

### Notification

The Dean of the College of Musical Arts will notify students selected for the Hansen Fellowship by April 1.

The HFC will develop a ranked list of alternates to draw from in case a student declines an offer. Finalists not offered a Fellowship will be sent a letter that they have been placed on the alternate list or that they have not been chosen.
