# A Resolution Formally Supporting the Implementation of an Anti-Cyberbullying policy to be put into the student code of conduct

- 3. Whereas, Bowling Green State University and the Undergraduate Student Government
- 4. aim to ensure all student voices are represented within the Senate; and
- 5. Whereas, the student code of conduct is the law of the campus that the whole student
- 6. body follows, it would be in the best interest of the University and the students to add an
- 7. anti-cyberbullying policy to the student code of conduct; and
- 8. Whereas the Bowling Green State University does not currently have a policy in place for
- 9. cyberbullying; and
- 10. Whereas, Cyberbullying is defined as the use of information technology to bully a person by
- 11. sending or posting text or images of an intimidating or threatening nature; and
- 12. Whereas, the mission of the university is to "Support all individuals to build a quality
- 13. learning community that fosters diversity and inclusion, collaboration, creativity, and
- 14. excellence"; and
- 15. Whereas, Cyberbullying is against this mission; and
- 16. Therefore, let it be resolved that, the Undergraduate Student Government of Bowling
- 17. Green State University advises the acting administration to add a policy of anti-cyberbullying
- 18. to the student code of conduct.
