In the Senate of the Undergraduate Student Body here assembled,

- 1. Whereas, the Undergraduate Student Government represents the undergraduate student voice
- 2. at Bowling Green State University; and
- 3. Whereas, Bowling Green State University and the Undergraduate Student Government
- 4. aims to ensure all student voices are represented within the Senate; and
- 5. Whereas, as a public university, "BGSU focuses on contributing to the public good and
- 6. embraces its role as a national model in addressing the educational, economic, and social
- 7. vitality of our region, the state of Ohio, the nation, and the world;" ¹and
- 8. Whereas, the 5th objective of the university is to "Enhance the quality and value of a BGSU 9. education ..."; and
- 10. Whereas, Bowling Green State University works to ensure students are able to graduate 11. in 4 years; and
- 12. Whereas, Bowling Green State University has a goal to reach a 50% 4-year graduation rate 13. by 2024; and
- 14. Whereas, many high achieving students choose to add double majors, extra
- 15. specializations, dual degrees or additional minors which increases the time spent at BGSU;
- 16. and
- 17. Whereas, the goal of the Deciding Student Program is for students to declare a major by
- 18. their third semester, meaning the first year has not been spent taking major coursework;
- 19. and
- 20. Whereas, the current undergraduate tuition rate allows undergraduate students to take up
- 21. to 18 credit hours each semester without incurring any additional fees; and

- 22. Whereas, Purdue University ², Penn State University ³, The University of Illinois at
- 23. Urbana Champaign ⁴, Rutgers University ⁵, the University of Southern California ⁶, and The
- 24. Ohio State University⁷ have instituted policies that allow undergraduate students to petition
- 25. to take over 18 credit hours per semester without having to pay any additional fees.
- 26. Therefore, let it be resolved that, the Undergraduate Student Government at Bowling
- 27. Green State University supports the adoption of policies and procedures that allow specific
- 28. students to take up to 21 credit hours each semester without having to incur any additional
- 29. fees with advisor referral/permission; and
- 31. Let it be Further Resolved these students will be defined as those taking advantage of
- 32. internships and research, those who would not graduate in four years without credit
- 33. overloading, and those who have applied to graduate.
