#### A Resolution Formally Supporting High Risk Community Members

In the Senate of the Undergraduate Student Body here assembled,

- 1. Whereas, the Undergraduate Student Government represents the undergraduate student voice
- 2. at Bowling Green State University; and
- 3. Whereas, Bowling Green State University and the Undergraduate Student Government
- 4. aim to ensure all student voices are represented within the Senate; and
- 5. Whereas, Bowling Green State University has updated their mask policy to no longer require
- 6. face coverings on campus; and
- 7. Whereas, this presents new and unique challenges to individuals who are
- 8. immunocompromised or otherwise high risk for health complications relating to COVID-19
- 9. and other communicable diseases; and
- 10. Whereas, individuals who have been diagnosed with cancer, chronic kidney disease, chronic
- 11. liver disease, cystic fibrosis, dementia, diabetes, heart conditions, HIV infections, or sickle
- 12. cell disease, as well as individuals who are overweight or pregnant, and individuals who may
- 13. have suffered a stroke or are otherwise immunocompromised are, according to the CDC, "at
- 14. higher risk of severe illness from COVID-19"; and
- 15. Whereas, older adults are also at an increased risk of experiencing severe illness from
- 16. COVID-19, with 81% of COVID-19 deaths occurring in individuals aged 65 and over
- 17. according to the CDC; and
- 18. Whereas, these two populations represent a large section of the community of BGSU
- 19. students, faculty, and staff, as well as their loved ones who they may reside with or be in
- 20. regular and requisite close contact with; and

- 21. Whereas, as lower COVID-19 reported case numbers may bring lower levels of concern for
- 22. some, many who are themselves or have loved ones who are at high risk for health
- 23. complications must still be highly attentive to the safety of their environments; and
- 24. Whereas, Bowling Green State University has declared a "goal of ensuring health and
- 25. safety of our community, as well as a successful academic year;"2 and
- 26. Whereas, faculty may still require face coverings in individual classroom settings based on
- 27. comfortability and need; and
- 28. Therefore, Let it be Resolved, that the Undergraduate Student Government strongly
- 29. recommends increased communication between faculty and students to make informed
- 30. decisions for individual classroom mask policy; and
- 31. Let it be Further Resolved, that the Undergraduate Student Government recommends the
- 32. assembly of self identified immunocompromised or otherwise high risk students or generally
- 33. interested students to voice specific concerns to the Chief Health and Wellness Officer; and
- 34. Let it be Further Resolved, that the Undergraduate Student Government supports the
- 35. continuation of the initiative to provide masks to students, faculty, and staff of Bowling
- 36. Green State University.
