Charting Marriage & Divorce in the U.S.: The Refined Divorce Rate, 2008-2023

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Beginning in 2008, the U.S. Census Bureau began asking respondents of the American Community Survey about events experienced in the past 12 months including marriages and divorces. In the same year, they also began asking respondents to report on the number of times they had been married. In conjunction with information on respondents' marital status, the NCFMR has been calculating and reporting on marriage and divorce rates in the U.S. from the time these variables were first made available to the public. In a special release series, we provide single year estimates charting marriage and divorce rates spanning the years 2008-2023. In this release, we focus on the refined divorce rate.



U.S. Refined Divorce Rate

The divorce rate has declined since 2008 for men and women aged 15 and older in the U.S.—a drop of 30.9% overall.

Figure 1. Refined Divorce Rate, 2008 & 2023








Figure 2. Women's Refined Divorce Rate, 2008-2023
