Was the student's parent or guardian killed in the line of duty while (1) serving on active duty as a member of the U.S. armed forces on or after September 11, 2001, or (2) performing official duties as a public safety officer*?		
*Note: Public safety officers include law enforcement officers, firefighters, chaplains, or members of a rescue squad or ambulance crew. Fire police officers include officers who serve as officially recognized or designated members of a legally organized public safety agency, and they provide scene security or direct traffic in response to any fire drill; fire call; other fire, rescue, or police emergency; or at a planned special event.

 Written letter of attestation or determination made by a state or local government official with supervisory or other relevant oversight authority of an individual who died in the line of duty while serving as a public safety officer. 		
O Documentation of the student qualifying for a state tuition or other state benefit accorded to the children or other family member of a public safety officer consistent with the definition in 42 U.S.C. 3796b, or as a fire police officer.
