BGSU COLLEGE OF MUSICAL ARTS 2024 AUDITION INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS

Ensemble Requirements:

- All undergraduate music majors are required to audition and enroll in a major ensemble each semester they are enrolled for applied lessons.
 Ensemble choices should be appropriate to the student's major and principal instrument.
- Most ensembles require a placement audition.
- Graduate music students choose the ensembles in which they wish to perform depending on their preference and in consultation with their studio teacher and ensemble directors.

Audition Schedules and Procedures

Choral Ensembles:

MIXED CHORUSES

A CAPPELLA CHOIR, COLLEGIATE CHORALE, UNIVERSITY CHORAL SOCIETY

All university students are invited to audition for the BGSU mixed choruses. To audition for the A Cappella Choir, Collegiate Chorale, or University Choral Society, please sign up for a time at <u>Fall 24 BGSU Mixed Choir Auditions</u>. Auditionees are asked to bring a prepared piece and will have an assessment of sight-singing and musicianship skills.

A CAPPELLA CHOIR (MWF 1:30-2:20 PM)

Dr. Adam Luebke, conductor

The A Cappella Choir is a select ensemble of approximately 50-60 singers, consisting primarily of undergraduate music majors.

COLLEGIATE CHORALE (MW at 2:30-3:20 PM and TR at 2:30-3:45 PM) Dr. Richard Schnipke, conductor

The Collegiate Chorale is a highly select ensemble of approximately 40 singers, consisting primarily of upperclassmen and graduate students studying music.

UNIVERSITY CHORAL SOCIETY (Tues. 7:30-9:30 PM)

Dr. Adam Luebke, conductor

The UCS is a large chorus consisting of students, faculty, staff, and community members. Each

year the UCS presents their "Joyous Sounds" holiday concert and performs a major choral/orchestral work with the BGSU Philharmonia or the Toledo Symphony Orchestra.

VOLARÉ (MWF at 12:30 – 1:20 PM)

Volaré (formerly University Women's Chorus) is a large ensemble consisting of soprano and alto singers with a variety of majors. UNIVERSITY MEN'S CHORUS (MWF at 12:30 – 1:20)

The University Men's Chorus is a large ensemble consisting of tenor and bass singers with a variety of majors. Those interested in the chorus should attend the first rehearsal with Dr. Schnipke on Monday, August 26 in the Conrad Room (102) of the Wolfe Center. Students auditioning for the A Cappella Choir, Collegiate Chorale, or University Choral Society <u>do not</u> need do schedule a separate audition for the University Men's Chorus.

- · Scales
- · Sight reading
- · Prepared jazz etude or transcription
- · Improvisation
- Saxophones 1:00-1:50, trumpets 1:50-2:40, trombones 2:40-3:30.
- · Auditions heard in order of arrival

<u>Chamber Jazz Ensemble Horns</u> (all non-rhythm section instruments): Tuesday, August 27, from 6:00-7:30 pm, Room 2019b

- · Prepare an American songbook tune or a jazz standard. Play melody and solo.
- · Auditions heard in order of arrival

BG Philharmonia Audition Instructions Fall 2024 -please read carefully-

Preparing your Orchestra Audition: Start early! Be prepared!

Part I Everyone must bring a prepared solo to the audition.

You will play a passage from it as requested by the faculty present.

Part II Orchestra Excerpts

- 1. Download and print out the excerpts for your instrument or use on your device. NOTE: Violinists can choose to audition on Violin I OR II.
- 2. Prepare all excerpts posted for your instrument. The audition committee will select which ones you perform at the audition.
- 3. Listen to a recording while following the excerpts to learn tempo and musical style.
- 4. Contact your teacher if you have any questions about the excerpts.

NOTE TO ALL HORN PLAYERS! You must prepare the Exposition of Mozart's Horn Concerto No. 2, K. 417 in E-flat as their solo.
